RULES FOR USING THE LAIR ROOM

- 1. Users holding a valid Library Card have the right to use the room.
- 2. Children over 1 year of age are allowed to use the room.
- 3. Children under 10 years of age may only use the room when supervised by an adult quardian.
- 4. Before playing with bricks, you should always clean your hands.
- 5. Bricks should be separated using a special LEGO separator, you must not use your teeth or sharp objects to do this. If you have any problems separating bricks, you should ask a Library employee for help.
- 6. Those who use the room take liability for returning all bricks along with instructions used while playing in an unchanged condition. In the case of minors, the liability is borne by their guardian.
- 7. Should bricks, instructions or other equipment be destroyed, the costs of repair are borne by the user or a guardian of a minor.
- 8. After each use, the bricks should be placed in a designated container.
- 9. You must not bring any bricks and toys from the outside to the room.
- 10. You should not displace constructions made of LEGO bricks displayed on the shelves.
- 11. It is forbidden to eat and drink in the room.
- 12. Employees reserve the right to shorten the playtime and request the users to leave the room if they fail to comply with the applicable rules.
- 13. You should leave the room at least 30 minutes before the Library closes.
